

3 Eligibility

1. Master's Programs and Integrated Master's & Doctoral Programs

A. International applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① He or she holds (or is about to hold) a Bachelor's degree
- ② He or she is not a citizen of Korea
- ③ His or her parents are not citizens of Korea

* Applicants who hold dual Korean citizenship are prohibited from applying. Citizenship status is determined as that which is held at the date of the application deadline.

B. Applicants of Korean origin must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① He or she received their entire elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate education outside of Korea at a comparable and equivalent level to that which is provided

in Korea

② He or she holds (or is about to hold) a Bachelor's degree

* Applicants who hold dual Korean citizenship are prohibited from applying. Citizenship status is determined as that which is held at the date of the application deadline.

2. Doctoral Programs

A. International applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

① He or she holds (or is about to hold) a Master's degree

② He or she is not a citizen of Korea

③ His or her parents are not citizens of Korea

* Applicants who hold dual Korean citizenship are prohibited from applying. Citizenship status is determined as that which is held at the date of the application deadline.

B. Applicants of Korean origin must meet all of the following requirements:

① He or she received their entire elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate education outside of Korea at a comparable and equivalent level to that which is provided in Korea

② He or she holds (or is about to hold) a Master's degree

* Applicants who hold dual Korean citizenship are prohibited from applying. Citizenship status is determined as that which is held at the date of the application deadline.

3. Eligibility for Language Proficiency

B. Except for the departments above, applicants(Master's Programs, Doctoral Programs, Master's and Combined Master's/ Doctoral Programs) must provide one of the following as proof of language proficiency:

① Korean proficiency: A "TOPIK" certificate for level 3 or higher

② English proficiency: A score report from a recognized English proficiency test such as: TOEFL 530(CBT 197, iBT 71), IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2, TEPS 600 Points, TOEIC 700 or higher

③ Be a native English speaker

- * A native English-speaking countries: the United States of America, the United Kingdom, Canada, the Republic of South Africa, New Zealand, Australia, Ireland
- ④ A confirmation letter of English or Korean proficiency issued by the department after the initial admission interview

4 Application Procedure

1. Application Period

- A. On-line Application: October 28(Mon) to November 8(Fri) in 2019, by 18:00
 - ① Application Site: To be announced at a later date on the KNU website. (<http://en.knu.ac.kr>)
 - ② Application Number: Automatically created after you complete the on-line application.
- B. **Submission of Applications:** All required documents should be submitted to the Office of International Affairs using one of the following methods:
 - ① In person
 - ② By Post (either express or regular registered post-mail)
- A. Application Submission Period: October 28(Mon) to November 15(Fri) in 2019, by 18:00
- B. Where to Submit: The Office of International Affairs at Kyungpook National University (Global Plaza 6F, Room 608)
- C. How to Submit: Applicants should submit completed and printed application forms downloaded from the online application site, along with required documents ①~⑩ in section 5 Required Documents. (Financial documents should be submitted after the department interview, except for applicants who can submit financial documents indicating funds of about USD18,000.
- * All required documents must be submitted by the last day.

2. Qualification Screening

- A. Screening Period: November 18(Mon) to November 25(Mon), 2019
- B. Screening Method: Examination of the suitability of applicants academic background and language proficiency, so as to be deemed as “qualified” or “unqualified.”

3. Department Screening(Interview)

- A. Screening Period: November 27(Wed) to December 6(Fri), 2019
- B. **Screening Method: Interview with each of major**
 - * **Interviews by telephone or internet are not acceptable for the following departments:**

- C. **Each departments will make notice for the interview schedule and place.**
- D. Comprehensive evaluation of the candidate’s previous degree performance, language eligibility, study plan, and major knowledge, so as to be deemed as “qualified” or “unqualified” by each of applied majors.
- E. Language eligibility will be screened and 『a confirmation letter of English or Korean proficiency』 will be issued for the qualified.

2. Financial Documents

- A. For whom: Applicants who have passed Admissions Committee Screening
- B. Submission Period: December 16(Mon) to December 23(Mon), 2019
- C. Required documents to submit **must** meet one of the following ①,②
 - ① **Original bank certificate of deposit balance(in English) showing the amount of USD18,000**
 - * According to the Ministry of Justice's and Education Guidelines.
 - * Submit bank deposit balance certificate in name of applicant **one's name** or **parent's name**.
 - * Submit the certificate of employment or business registration certificate(English or Korean) of parent's when submitting the balance certificate of the parent's name.
 - * Issued within 30 days prior to the submission date.
 - ② **Scholarship Certificates from Other Organizations**
- A. If applicants are financially supported from their own countries' government or another organization
- B. If an academic advisor is the financial guarantor, the academic advisor's certificate of financial support and his/her employment certificate can be substituted for the above documents. (KNU format will be provided to academic advisors directly upon request)

3. Academic Degree Verification Documents

- A. For whom: Final successful applicants
- B. When: by February 28(Fri), 2020
- C. Required documents: Successful applicants must submit one of the following documents ①,②,③
 - ① **Apostille Certificate** of your previous academic documents
 - ② Documents **verified by the Korean Embassy in other countries or the Embassy in Korea**
 - ③ Documents **confirmed by the China Academic Degree & Graduate Education Development Center**(Only for applicants who hold a degree from universities in China)
 - * Applicants who graduated from Universities in Korea can submit a copy of the degree instead of verified copies

⑥ Application Fee: KRW60,000

- 1. The application fee should be paid using the on-line payment system.
- 2. Failure to pay the application fee during the application period will result in cancellation.
- 3. You can get the application number after payment of the application fee.
 - * NOTE: It is not possible to revise the contents of the application after payment.

7 Scholarships(KINGS: KNU International Graduate Scholarships) and Benefits

1. **Selection Period:** Before the beginning of every semester up to 4th semester

2. **Benefits:** 100% or 50% of tuition fees waived

3. Number of Selected Applicants

A. New international students: up to 70 applicants based on 100% tuition payment

B. Enrolled international students: up to 210 applicants based on 100% tuition payment

4. Qualification

A. New Students

A-2) Up to 70 applicants based on 100% tuition payment

B. Enrolled Students

B-1) International graduate students scheduled for next semester who meet the following two conditions and also nominated by department



* Professors will recommend students for KINGS based on their academic performance, language ability, etc.

8 Important Notes for Applicants

1. All documents should be in Korean or English. Documents in another language should be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation.
2. If any required documents are found to be false or counterfeit, your application will be canceled.
3. Any applicant submitting a certificate of expected graduation must submit the original copy or a notarized copy of the graduation certificate before beginning their first semester at Kyungpook National University.
4. The Office of International Affairs is not responsible for application cancellation due to incorrect contact information (such as address and phone number, etc.).
5. If an applicant's visa is not issued or is rejected, his or her application will be canceled.
6. Applicants receiving a scholarship from another institution are not required to submit a certificate of financial guarantee; however, they must submit a certificate/letter from the institution confirming that they will pay your tuition during your period of study at Kyungpook National University.
7. No submitted documents or application fees will be returned to the applicant. (Original copies of certificates of degree will be returned after the screening process is completed.)
