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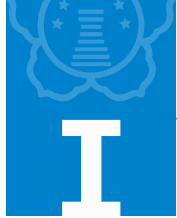
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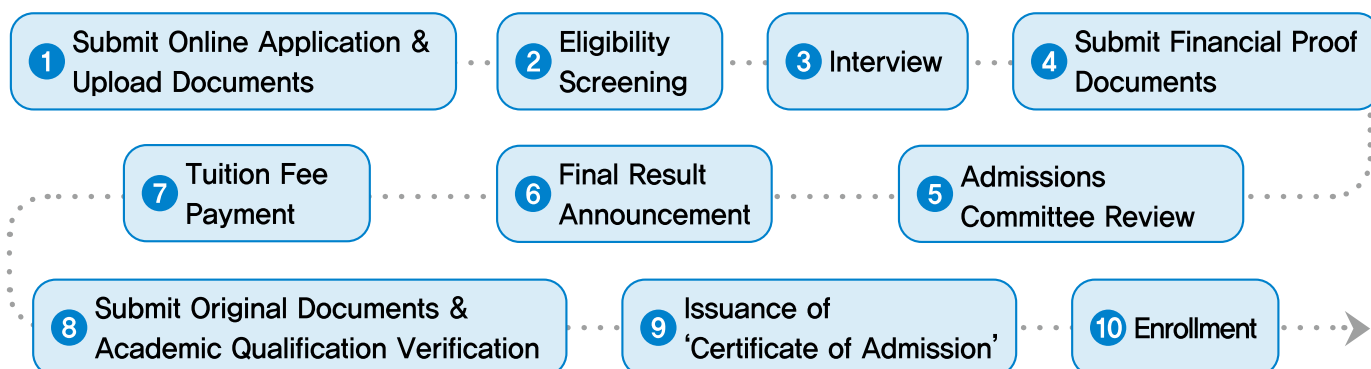

1. Program Overview:

During the first year, students will complete various curricular and extracurricular programs, including Academic Korean and major exploration courses. Upon advancement to the second year, students will select their desired major and be officially assigned to that department.

2. Language of Instruction: Korean

3. Major Selection: To be eligible for major selection, students must:

- ① Complete two semesters and earn at least 27 credits; and
- ② Meet the Korean language proficiency requirement (TOPIK or TOPIK IBT) of the department they wish to enter. (Detailed requirements will be announced prior to the second year.)

※ Upon advancement to the second year, students may choose any department available under the International Special Admission program, except for the Department of History Education and departments in the Arts and PE fields.

※ Available departments and the quota for each department will be announced after enrollment.

※ If the number of applicants exceeds the quota for a department, students will be assigned to their 1st through 5th choice in order based on their first-year GPA, TOPIK scores, and other relevant criteria. (Students who are not assigned to a department will be assigned to a department with available capacity after individual consultation with the Dean and consideration of their academic performance.)

※ NOTES:

- ① Most courses in the Undergraduate Program are conducted in Korean, but some courses are taught in English.
- ② School of Architecture (Major in Architecture) is a 5-year program.
- ③ Students who are enrolled in the Department of Civil Engineering, Agricultural Civil Engineering, or Smart Bio-Industrial Mechanical Engineering must complete the ABEEK (Accreditation Board for Engineering Education of Korea) program. For transfer students, graduation may be delayed by one or more semesters depending on the number of credits recognized from the previous institution.
- ④ The Departments of Mechanical Engineering, Music, Design, and Fine Arts accept new students in the Spring semester only.
- ⑤ The Department of History Education at the Teachers College can admit up to 10% of the enrollment quota in accordance with the Ministry of Education's 'Guidelines for Operating Teacher Training Institutions Beyond the Quota'.
- ⑥ Preliminary successful candidates can only apply to the department they have been accepted into. (Preliminary admission becomes invalid if the department is changed.)

4 Eligibility

〈Nationality Requirement for All Applicants〉

- Applicants and both of their parents must be non-Korean nationals.
 - * Nationality criterion is evidenced only if applicants and both of their parents acquire non-Korean nationality by the time the applicant begins the curriculum corresponding to the educational programs of Korean high schools.
- Multi-nationals with Korean citizenship are not eligible.
- Eligible Nationality Status must be established before the application due date.

1. Freshmen Admissions (Applicable to both Track I and Track II)

He or she must have completed his or her entire elementary and junior high school education, and he or she must have completed high school education at a comparable and equivalent level to that which is provided in Korea. (Spring Semester: including applicants expected to graduate in February 2027; Fall Semester: including applicants expected to graduate in August 2027)

- ※ Applicants who completed the curriculum through homeschooling, online education, adult education, or domestic or overseas high school equivalency examinations (e.g. GED) are NOT eligible for enrollment.

- Applicants should complete all formal education in ONE country.
- Applicants who have studied in more than 2 countries should complete 12 years of education.
 - Applicants who have completed less than 11 years should apply for high school as a regular student or transfer student within Korea or overseas.
 - In the case of 11-year foreign systems (see chart above), applicants should complete the last 3 years of education in ONE country in order to acquire high school qualification.
 - For students with unfinished years due to a gap in their education system, the period of years at an overseas university will be counted as equivalent to Korean high school years.

Criteria for Qualification of High School Graduation

- High school graduation should be completed by the day prior to the opening day of admission to KNU in order to qualify. However, for applicants from countries in which the academic year and the opening day of school differ by more than one (1) month from Korea (e.g., Japan), one (1) full month of attendance at an overseas high school will be approved as equivalent to graduation.

2. Transfer Admissions to 3rd Year (Applicable to Track I Only)

Graduated (or expected to graduate) from a 2 or 3-year accredited college, or completed at least two years (4 semesters) of a 4-year university program (over 65 credit hours).

※ NOTES:

- 1) Applicants can apply only with the same or similar major as the university major they studied.
- 2) Those who have completed two years at a 3-year university are not eligible.
- 3) Those who graduated from a university that does not have a credit system are not eligible.
- 4) Those who are enrolled at KNU cannot apply for transfer admission.
- 5) Applicants who completed any part of their educational curriculum through homeschooling, online education, adult education, or domestic or overseas high school equivalency examinations (e.g. GED) are NOT eligible for enrollment.

3. Eligibility for Language Proficiency

A. Transfer Applicants

1) Department of Media and Communication: Level 5 TOPIK (TOPIK IBT) Certificate (or higher)

2) Other Departments: Level 4 TOPIK (TOPIK IBT) Certificate (or higher)

※ Applicants may apply by submitting a TOPIK (or TOPIK IBT) test registration slip for a recognized test session at the time of application. [Applicants who submit a test registration slip must submit an official score report with Level 4 or higher by (Spring Semester) **Dec. 21, 2026 (Mon), 13:00** / (Fall Semester) **June 2027 (detailed schedule TBA).**]

※ Applicants to the Department of Media and Communication, Mechanical Engineering and the School of Economics and Trade must submit a TOPIK (TOPIK IBT) report by the application deadline.

③ One of the following English language proficiency test scores (or higher):

TOEFL IBT 59, IELTS 5.5, NEW TEPS 202, CEFR B2

※ Only scores obtained by the application deadline will be accepted.

※ Applicants who are citizens of an English-speaking country (the US, the UK, Canada, South Africa, New Zealand, Australia, or Ireland) may satisfy by submitting documents verifying completion of their secondary education.

④ Completion of Level 3 or higher of the Korea Immigration and Integration Program (KIIP), or a score of 61 or above on the KIIP Pre-Evaluation

⑤ Completion of the Basic Korean Language Program (Intermediate Korean 1 or higher) issued by an overseas Sejong Institute (Online Sejong Institute courses are not accepted.)

Track II (Department of Global Liberal Arts)

① Level 3 TOPIK (TOPIK IBT) Certificate or higher

② Completion of Level 3 or higher in a Korean language program offered by KNU

※ Current KNU Korean Language Program Students will be recognized if they complete Level 3 or higher by:

- Spring Semester: **Nov. 13, 2026 (Fri)**
- Fall Semester: **May 14, 2027 (Fri)**

C. Preliminary successful candidates must submit the required language proficiency test scores specified by their applied department by:

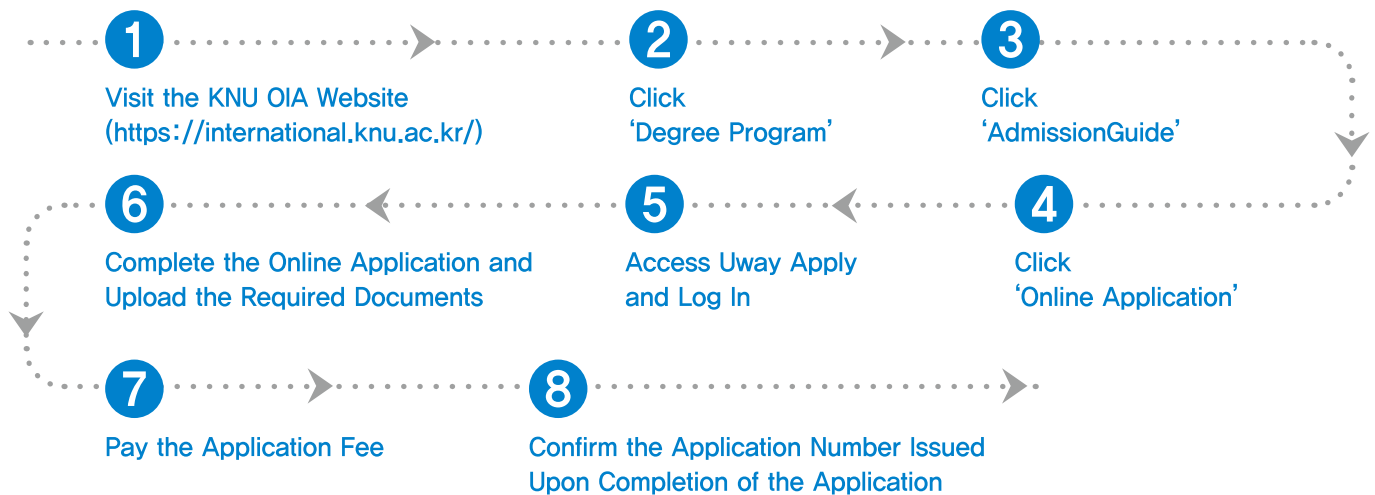
C. Application Number: Automatically generated upon successful completion of the online application

D. Application Procedure:

- During the application period, upload the required documents listed in “6. Required Documents” (Page 11).
- Upload one PDF file for each document item (① – ⑭).

※ Do NOT upload all required documents as a single PDF file

Online Application Process



- ▶ Upload the required documents (1) in the order listed under “6. Required Documents” and (2) as one PDF file per document item.
- ▶ Applications applying to both Track I and Track II must upload a separate set of application documents for each application number.
- ▶ An application is considered complete only after the application fee has been paid. Once payment has been made, no changes may be made to the application.
- ▶ The application fee will be fully refunded if the application is withdrawn **before 18:00 on Oct. 30, 2026** (Spring Semester) or **before 18:00 on Apr. 30, 2027** (Fall Semester). No refund will be provided after the application deadline.
- ▶ Applicants should keep their **five-digit application number** for future reference.
- ▶ Heavy website traffic is expected on the application deadline. Applicants are strongly advised to complete their application well in advance.

B. Administering Office: KNU Office of International Affairs

- ※ Applicants to the Department of Fine Arts are required to participate in an on-site practical exam.

C. Interview Method: Online interview (e.g. Zoom)

- 1) Applicants will be individually notified of the date and Zoom link for their interview.
 - 2) Evaluation is based on Korean language proficiency, basic academic knowledge in their intended field of study, and overall academic ability. Applicants will be classified as “Eligible” or “Ineligible.”
- ※ Preliminary successful candidates are exempt from the interview.

2 Apostille

Since July 14, 2007, the Republic of Korea has been part of the 1961 Hague Convention abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents. The “Apostille” designation ensures that public documents issued in one signatory country will be recognized as valid in another signatory country.
