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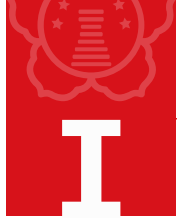
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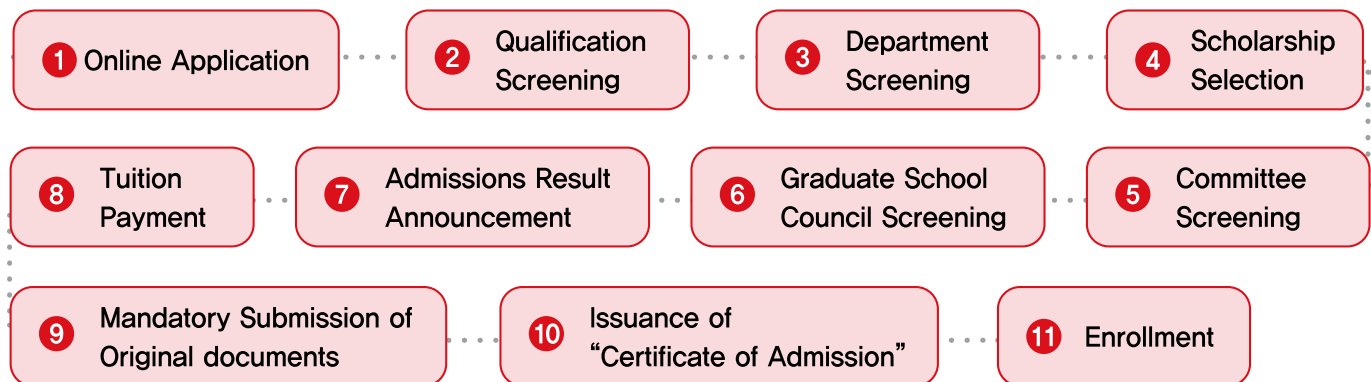

4 Eligibility

※ Applicants who hold dual Korean citizenship are prohibited from applying. Citizenship status is determined as that which is held at the date of the application deadline.

1. Master's Programs and Integrated Master's & Doctoral Programs

A. International applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① Holds (or is about to hold) a Bachelor's degree.
- ② Must be a non-Korean national.
- ③ Both parents must be non-Korean nationals.

B. Applicants of Korean origin (entire education completed abroad) must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① Holds (or is about to hold) a Bachelor's degree.
- ② Must be a non-Korean national.
- ③ Received their entire elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate education outside of Korea at a comparable and equivalent level to that provided in Korea.

2. Doctoral Programs

A. International applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① Holds (or is about to hold) a Master's degree
- ② Must be a non-Korean national.
- ③ Both parents must be non-Korean nationals.

B. Applicants of Korean origin (entire education completed abroad) must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① Holds (or is about to hold) a Master's degree
- ② Received their entire elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate education outside of Korea at a comparable and equivalent level to that provided in Korea.
- ③ Must be a non-Korean national.

3. Eligibility for Language Proficiency

A. Applicants are eligible to apply to the following 26 departments only if they satisfy the language proficiency requirement of the respective department.

※ Applicants may apply by submitting a TOPIK test registration slip for a recognized test session at the time of application, (except for the Department of Media and Communication)

[Applicants who submit a test registration slip must submit an official score report by:

- Spring Semester: Dec. 10, 2026(Thu), 13:00
- Fall Semester: May 2027 (Detailed schedule TBA)]

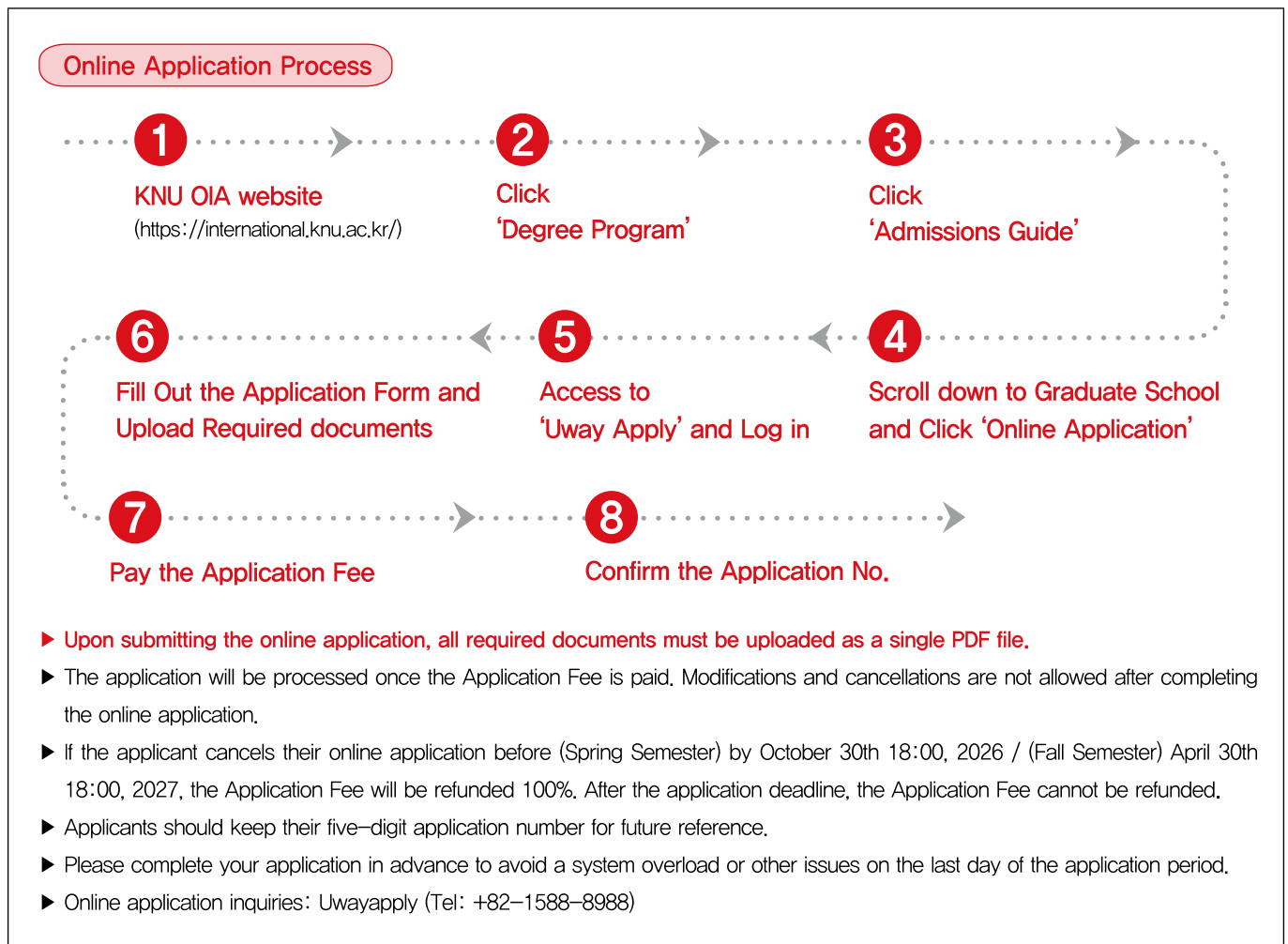
B. Applicants applying to departments other than the above 26 departments must satisfy at least one of the following language proficiency requirements:

- ① Korean language proficiency: TOPIK certificate for Level 3 or higher
- ② English language proficiency: a score report from a recognized English proficiency test such as: TOEFL iBT 59, IELTS (Academic) 5.5, CEFR B2, NEW TEPS 202 or higher
- ③ Native speakers of English
 - * Applicants do not need to submit an English score report if they are from a country whose official language is English (USA, UK, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Republic of South Africa, and Ireland).
- ④ Non-native speakers of English or Korean, with required ability but no test score
 - * In this case, the required ability will be separately evaluated during the department interview and reported to the OIA with a confirmation letter.

- B. Application website: Uwayapply
- C. How to apply: Input the required information on the site and upload documents ① to ⑪ from the “⑥Application Documents 1.” list as a single PDF file
- D. Application Number: Automatically created upon completing the online application.



2. Qualification Screening

- A. Screening Period: (Spring Semester) November 2 (Mon) ~ November 16 (Mon), 2026
(Fall Semester) May 4 (Tue) ~ May 17 (Mon), 2027
- B. Screening Method: Examination of the suitability of applicants' academic background and language proficiency, so as to be deemed as "Qualified" or "Unqualified."

3. Departmental Screening (Interviews)

- A. Screening Period: (Spring Semester) November 18 (Wed) ~ November 27 (Fri), 2026
(Fall Semester) May 19 (Wed) ~ May 28 (Fri), 2027

- B. Screening Method: In-person (face-to-face) interviews or non-face-to-face (video) interviews according to each department's discretion

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- C. **Each department will notify its respective applicants of the interview schedule and location.**
- D. Comprehensive evaluation of each candidate's previous degree performance, language eligibility, study plan, and major knowledge will be performed, so as to be deemed as "Qualified" or "Unqualified" for each of the majors to which they have applied.
- E. After language eligibility is screened, a Confirmation Letter of English or Korean Proficiency will be issued for all qualified applicants.

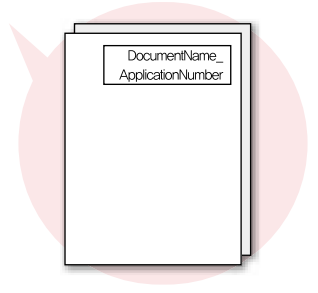

※ Important Notes for Document Submission:

- ① All documents should be in Korean or English. Documents in other languages should be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation.
- ② When uploading application documents, combine the documents listed as ① – ⑪ under “[6] Required Documents – 1” into a single PDF file arranged the specified order.
- ③ Passport: Submit a copy of a valid passport that has not expired.
Applicants must notify the OIA of any changes to their passport information.
– Applicants holding Uzbekistani citizenship must submit an international passport.
- ④ Documents showing the relationship between the applicant and his or her parents:
– The document should state the nationality and relationship between the applicant and parents. (Documents should be notarized in Korean or English if the original documents are in other languages.



※ Only certificates/documents notarized within 6 months before submission will be accepted.

- If parents are deceased (or divorced), a Death (or Divorce) Certificate should be submitted.

- D. Applicants must submit one of the following (① or ②):
 - ① Original Bank Balance Certificate equivalent to KRW 16,000,000 or more (issued in Korean or English)
 - * In accordance with the guidelines of the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Education.
 - * A bank balance certificate issued under the applicant's or parent's name may be submitted.
 - * If the bank balance certificate is issued under a parent's name, the applicant must also submit the parent's certificate of employment or business registration certificate (in Korean or English).
 - * Bank balance certificates issued under the name of anyone other than the applicant or the applicant's parent(s) will not be accepted, except in special circumstances.
 - * The certificate must have been issued within 30 days prior to the date of submission.
 - * Applicants of Uzbekistani nationality residing in Uzbekistan must submit a bank balance certificate issued only by KDB Uzbekistan. The stated balance must be maintained in the account for at least three months after the certificate is issued.
 - * For bank balance certificates issued by banks in China, the account must be frozen until (Spring Semester) Feb. 28, 2027 / (Fall Semester) Aug. 30, 2027.

② Scholarship Award (Financial Support) Certificate

- 1) Applicants receiving financial support from their home country's government or other organizations
 - ※ If the total scholarship amount is less than KRW 16,000,000, additional financial guarantee documents must be submitted to cover the shortfall.

1. **Application Fee:** 80,000 KRW

2. **Payment Method**

- A. Payment must be made through the online application program.
- B. Failure to pay the application fee within the application period will result in automatic cancellation of the application.
- C. After payment of the application fee, an application number will be assigned and the application form will be printed. The application will be considered complete. Modifications to the application form will not be permitted after payment has been completed.

3. **Applications cannot be cancelled after payment has been completed, and the application fee is non-refundable.**

1. **Excellent KINGS: Excellent KNU International Graduate Scholarships**

- 1) Selection Target: Freshmen
- 2) Benefit: Full tuition fees waived for the first semester
- 3) Number of students selected: Approximately 40
- 4) Qualifications: If at least one of the following three criteria are met, it will be subject to review
 - A. Outstanding overseas university graduate based on the following World University Rankings:
 - THE (Times Higher Education) World University Rankings Top 500
 - QS World University Rankings Top 500
 - B. Applicants who are graduates of the undergraduate program at KNU and are advancing to the Master's (or the Master's and Doctoral Combined) program.
 - Applicants must have a graduation GPA of B0 (3.0) or higher and a recommendation letter from a prospective advisor.

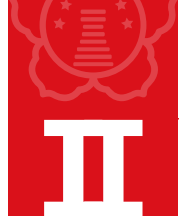

1 Performance Test for Admissions into the Department of Music

- The Departmental Assessment (Student Ability Test) for the Department of Music is a performance test, and applicants must prepare their test pieces (see below) and perform them in person. (The Department will notify applicants of the test schedule after the eligibility check period.)
- If an applicant is not residing in Korea during the Departmental Assessment Period, one may submit a video recording of a musical performance of one's test piece. However, one can only submit a video that was recorded during the application period. For composition majors, applicants must submit the score of the composition they created as part of the examination.
- In cases where the submitted video is fake or forged in any way, the applicant's permission for admission can be revoked.
- For applicants to the music theory major who are not residing in Korea, the Department Screening will be scheduled separately and announced accordingly.

2 Apostille

Since July 14, 2007, the Republic of Korea has been part of the 1961 Hague Convention abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents. The Convention provides for the use of simplified certification of public documents (including notarized documents) among countries that have joined the convention. The Apostille designation ensures that public documents issued in one signatory country will be recognized as valid in another signatory country.

※ **NOTE** : Newly admitted students from countries that are signatories to the convention must meet the following requirements:

- ① Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from public schools or institutions should be submitted together with an "Apostille" attachment.
- ② Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from private schools or institutions, however, should be officially notarized by a notary, agency, or any other authority competent under the law of the country of origin of the certificates; then, the certificates should be submitted together with an "Apostille" attachment.
