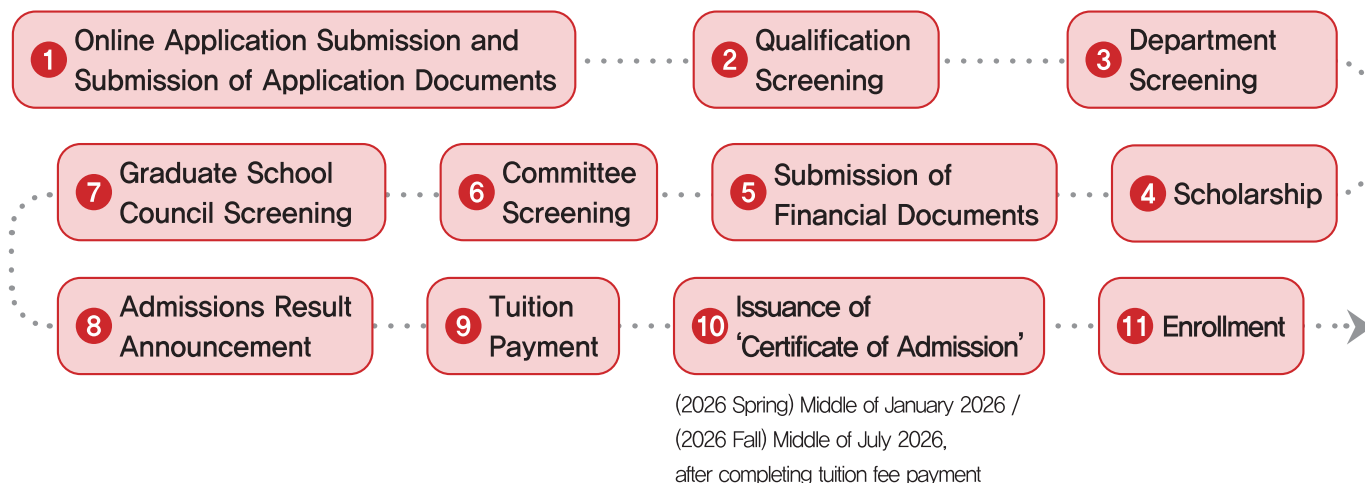

4 Eligibility

※ Applicants who hold dual Korean citizenship are prohibited from applying. Citizenship status is determined as that which is held at the date of the application deadline.

1. Master's Programs and Integrated Master's & Doctoral Programs

A. International applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① Holds (or is about to hold) a Bachelor's degree.
- ② Must be a non-Korean national.
- ③ Both parents must be non-Korean nationals.

B. Applicants of Korean origin (entire education completed abroad) must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① Holds (or is about to hold) a Bachelor's degree.
- ② Must be a non-Korean national.
- ③ Received their entire elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate education outside of Korea at a comparable and equivalent level to that provided in Korea.

2. Doctoral Programs

A. International applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① Holds (or is about to hold) a Bachelor's degree.
- ② Must be a non-Korean national.
- ③ Both parents must be non-Korean nationals.

B. Applicants of Korean origin (entire education completed abroad) must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① Holds (or is about to hold) a Master's degree
- ② Received their entire elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate education outside of Korea at a comparable and equivalent level to that provided in Korea.
- ③ Must be a non-Korean national.

3. Eligibility for Language Proficiency

A. Applicants who want to apply for the following departments MUST meet required conditions:

※ Applicants to the departments listed below must submit their transcript by the application submission date.

※ However, applicants for the Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) may apply with their test admission ticket from the designated session at the time of application for the Special Admissions for International Students.

[Applicants submitting test admission tickets must submit the language proficiency scores required by the department by 1:00 PM on Friday, December 12, 2025 (1st semester) / mid-May 2026 (2nd semester), with the detailed schedule to be announced later). Failure to submit or not meeting the requirements will result in disqualification.]

B. Except for the departments listed above, applicants must provide one of the following as proof of language proficiency:

- ① Korean language proficiency: TOPIK certificate for Level 3 or higher
- ② English language proficiency: a score report from a recognized English proficiency test such as: TOEFL iBT 59, IELTS (Academic) 5.5, CEFR B2, NEW TEPS 202 or higher
- ③ Native speakers of English

* Applicants do not need to submit an English score report if they are from a country whose official language is English (USA, UK, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Republic of South Africa, and Ireland).

④ Non-native speakers of English or Korean, with required ability but no test score

* In this case, the required ability will be separately evaluated during the department interview and reported to the OIA with a confirmation letter.

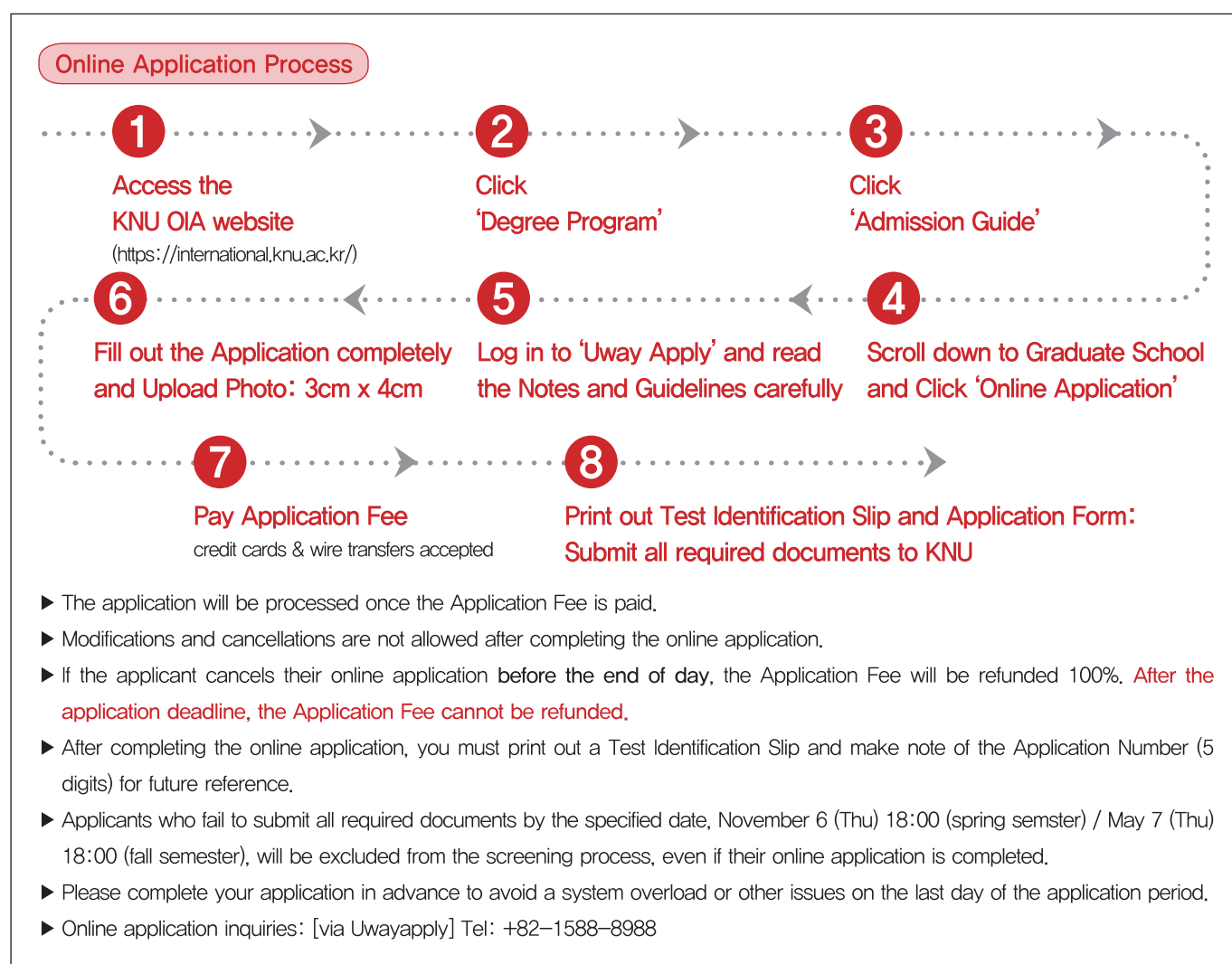

B. Submission of Applications: All required documents must be submitted to the KNU OIA in person or by post.

① Submission Period: (Spring Semester) September 29, 2025 (Mon) 09:00 ~ November 6 (Thu) 18:00 / (Fall Semester) March 30, 2026 (Mon) 09:00 ~ May 7 (Thu) 18:00

② Where to Submit: KNU OIA (Cheomseongin Student Futures Support Building 2F)

③ How to Submit: Applicants should submit their completed and printed application forms downloaded from

the online application site, along with required documents ①~⑪ in section ⑥ Required Documents.

2. Qualification Screening

- C. Each department will notify its respective applicants of the interview schedule and location.
- D. Comprehensive evaluation of each candidate's previous degree performance, language eligibility, study plan, and major knowledge will be performed, so as to be deemed as "Qualified" or "Unqualified" for each of the major to which they have applied.
- E. After language eligibility is screened, a Confirmation Letter of English or Korean Proficiency will be issued for all qualified applicants.

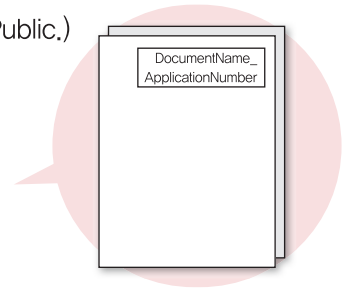

- 1) Applicants to the School of Business Administration and the Department of Dentistry should state their field of interest in their Statement of Purpose and Study Plan. (Ex: Accounting, Marketing, etc. – Business Administration / Oral Pathology, Orthodontics, etc – Dentistry)
- 2) Applicants to the Department of Music must prepare a practical test for the interview. Applicants who are outside of Korea should submit a video of their performance on USB with their other application documents. (Refer to page 17–18.)
- 3) Applicants to the Department of Fine Art or Design must submit ⑪ a Portfolio (size A4, 10 pages) together with their other application documents.
- 4) Applicants to the Department of Fine Art and Music should state their field of interest in their Statement of Purpose and Study Plan.

※ Notes

- ① All documents should be in Korean or English. Documents in other languages should be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation.
- ② When submitting copies of documents, you must submit the original documents for verification. (Alternatively, you may submit a Certified True Copy by a Notary Public.)
- ③ All required documents must be submitted in person or by post. (Email submission is not permitted.)
- ④ All documents should have the document name and application number written in the upper right corner before submission.
- ⑤ All required documents must be submitted in the order of the list above. (Do not use staples, clips, etc.)
- ⑥ Prospective graduates must submit their Certificate of Expected Graduation indicating their expected graduation date (year and month) when applying for admission.
 - Graduation Certificate: When submitting your application, submit a “Prospective Graduation Certificate” (with the expected graduation date indicated).
Upon final acceptance, submit the Graduation Certificate (original and notarized) and academic verification documents (China: 学信网 Certificate; Outside of China: Apostille or Embassy Certificate) to the Office of International Affairs by (Spring Semester) February 27, 2026 / (Fall Semester) August 28, 2026.
 - Transcript: When submitting your application, submit a transcript obtained by the application deadline. After graduation, submit your final transcript to the Office of International Affairs by (Spring Semester) February 27, 2026 / (Fall Semester) August 28, 2026.
- ⑦ Passport: The expiration date of the passport must be after the semester start date.
 - Applicants of the Uzbekistan national must submit the International passport.
- ⑧ Documents showing the relationship between the applicant and his or her parents
 - The document should state the nationality and relationship between the applicant and parents. (Documents should be notarized in Korean or English if the original documents are in other languages.)
 - Only certificates/documents notarized within 6 months before submission will be accepted.
 - If parents are deceased (or divorced), a Death (or Divorce) Certificate should be submitted.

2. Financial Documents

- A. For whom: Applicants who have passed the Department Screening
- B. Submission Period: After receiving the Department Screening Result until (Spring Semester) December 19, 2025 (Fri) / (Fall Semester) June 19, 2026 (Fri)
- C. Required documents MUST include one of the following and meet all requirements:
 - ① Original bank certificate of deposit balance (in English) showing a minimum of 16 million KRW
 - * According to the Ministry of Justice's and Education Guidelines
 - * Submit a bank deposit balance certificate in the applicant's own name or a parent's name.
 - * Submit a Certificate of Employment or Business Registration Certificate (English or Korean) of the parent

when submitting the balance certificate in the parent's name.

- * Bank balance certificates under other names (friends, relatives other than the applicants' parents, etc.) cannot be accepted.
- * Issued within 30 days prior to the submission date (Spring Semester) December 19, 2025 (Fri) / (Fall Semester) June 19, 2026 (Fri) will be accepted.
- * For students residing in Uzbekistan, only balance certificates issued by KDB Uzbekistan are accepted. Additionally, the balance must be maintained for at least 3 months after issuance.

② Scholarship Certificates from Other Organizations

- * If applicants are financially supported from their own countries' government or another organization, if the total amount of scholarship is insufficient for KRW 16 million, an additional financial guarantee for the shortfall is required.
- * If an academic advisor is serving as the financial guarantor, the academic advisor's Certificate of Financial Support and his/her Employment Certificate can be substituted for the above documents. (The official KNU format will be provided to academic advisors directly upon request, and should be submitted directly from the academic advisor to the KNU OIA.)

3. Academic Degree Verification Documents

A. For whom: Among the final successful applicants, those who were "expected to graduate" at the time of application but did not submit academic verification documents.

※ Graduates must submit academic verification documents by the application deadline.

B. Submission Period:

- Graduates: Submit with application documents (Spring Semester) by November 6, 2025 (Thu) / (Fall Semester) by May 7, 2026 (Thu)
- Expected Graduates: (Spring Semester) by February 27, 2026 (Fri) / (Fall Semester) by August 28, 2026 (Fri) (However, "Proof of Expected Graduation" and "Transcript" documents must be submitted with the application.)

C. Required Documents: Successful applicants must submit one of the following documents:

- ① Apostille Certificate of your previous academic documents
- ② Original Documents verified by the Korean Embassy in another country or the Embassy in Korea
 - * Simple photocopies or notarized copies of the apostilled (or consular confirmed) documents are NOT accepted. However, a certified true copy issued by the Korean Embassy or a certificate of true copy issued by a government agency that issued the original apostilled document will be accepted.
- ③ Documents confirmed by the China Academic Degree (CHSI) & Graduate Education Development Center (CDGDC) (Only for applicants who hold a degree from universities in China.)
 - * Certificate of Admission can be issued after submitting all verification documents stated above.
 - * Applicants who graduated from universities in Korea may submit a copy of their degree instead of a verified copy.

2. Payment Method

- a. Payment must be made through the online application program.
- b. Failure to pay the application fee within the application period will result in automatic cancellation of the application.
- c. After payment of the application fee, an application number will be assigned and the application form will be printed. The application will be considered complete. Modifications to the application form will not be permitted after payment has been completed.

3. **Applications cannot be cancelled after payment has been completed, and the application fee is non-refundable.**

8 Important Notes for Applicants

1. If any required documents are found to be false or counterfeit, the applicant's admission will be cancelled.
2. If the contact information is incorrectly provided on the application, resulting in failure to receive notifications, the applicant will be fully responsible for any consequences, including the cancellation of admission.
3. If an applicant's visa is not issued or is rejected, his or her admission will be cancelled.
4. Applicants receiving a scholarship of more than 16 million KRW from another institution are not required to submit a Certificate of Financial Guarantee; however, they must submit a Certificate/Letter of Confirmation from the institution that will pay their tuition during their period of study at Kyungpook National University.
5. Application Fees and submitted documents will not be returned.
6. As many applications will be expected on the last day of online application, please complete the application as soon as possible before the deadline.
7. As the Application Number is frequently used during the application process, be sure to make note of it separately when submitting the application.
8. If an applicant does not have sufficient academic ability, he or she may not be selected.
9. International students who are admitted to the university or enrolled at KNU must have Korean health insurance. According to the National Health Insurance Act and its Enforcement Decree, from March 1, 2021, international students who stay in Korea for more than 6 months must have National Health Insurance (국민건강보험) in Korea.
10. Further details, if not stated in this Guide, will be in accordance with the KNU Office of International Affairs. These Admissions Guidelines were originally written in Korean and translated into English and Chinese. Should there be any discrepancies between them, the Korean version supercedes all translated versions.

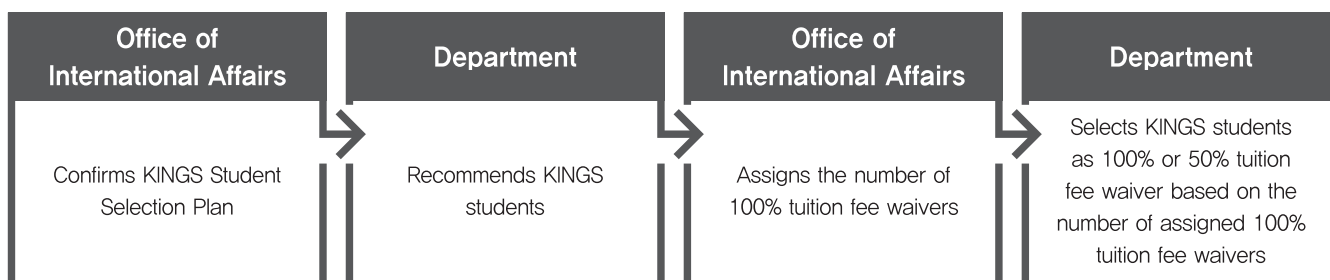

1 Performance Test for Admissions into the Department of Music

- The Departmental Assessment (Student Ability Test) for the Department of Music is a performance test, and applicants must prepare their test pieces (see below) and perform them in person. (The Department will notify applicants of the test schedule after the eligibility check period.)
- If an applicant is not residing in Korea during the Departmental Assessment Period, one may submit a video recording of a musical performance of one's test piece. However, one can only submit a video that was recorded during the application period. For composition majors, applicants must submit the score of the composition they created as part of the examination.
- In cases where the submitted video is fake or forged in any way, the applicant's permission for admission can be revoked.
- For applicants to the music theory major who are not residing in Korea, the Department Screening will be scheduled separately and announced accordingly.

2 Apostille

Since July 14, 2007, the Republic of Korea has been part of the 1961 Hague Convention abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents. The Convention provides for the use of simplified certification of public documents (including notarized documents) among countries that have joined the convention. The Apostille designation ensures that public documents issued in one signatory country will be recognized as valid in another signatory country.

※ **NOTE** : Newly admitted students from countries that are signatories to the convention must meet the following requirements:

- ① Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from public schools or institutions should be submitted together with an "Apostille" attachment.
- ② Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from private schools or institutions, however, should be officially notarized by a notary, agency, or any other authority competent under the law of the country of origin of the certificates; then, the certificates should be submitted together with an "Apostille" attachment.

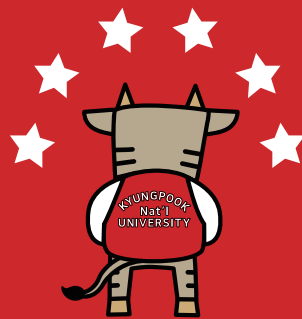
